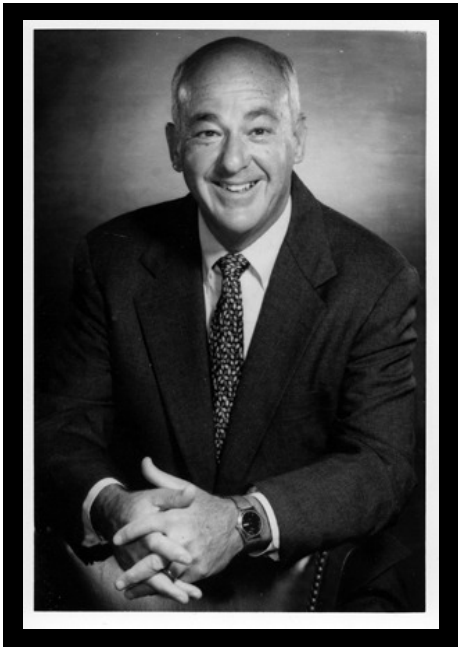


Nebraska Mass Fatality Seminar
